The Creative Learning Journey has been fully updated to meet the requirements of the new National Curriculum for 2014

Our **fully revised** online resources will be live by the end of January, with the existing CLJ also remaining online for all subscribing schools.

The NEW version has even greater flexibility:

- **The convenience of having the new documentation already translated into simple Learning Outcomes to make planning and assessment even easier**
- **The ability to reverse the process by selecting the NC statements you want to cover and have the Learning Outcomes automatically selected**
- **The ability to choose which areas of learning to include in your topic – from just 1 to all 7**

The CLJ allows you to tailor-make a cohesive curriculum that enriches learning, meets the needs of your particular pupil profile and fulfils the government's requirements.

As before, teachers also have access to the CLJ library, which contains thousands of topic wheels created by fellow professionals.

In addition, the CLJ continues to cover PSHE and RE – keeping the previous guidance as a basis for schools to build upon.
